REVIEW

All points remain unaltered except those detailed below; amendments are in italics as follows:-

Outcome:

- Requirement for after school and holiday clubs – *the school provides before and after school clubs, a holiday club was tried but interest was limited.*

Issues:

- The availability of IT/Broadband facilities – *Broadband is now available to most of the Parish and I.T. facilities are available in school as part of the Newton & Noss Network (see below).*
- Difficulty in finding appropriate building/facilities for indoor sports & leisure - *the School Hall has facilities.*

The way forward:

- Examine possibilities for improvement/better use of existing facilities – *the Sports Pavilion is being renovated and improved.*
- Form a youth council – *this was formed but has since been disbanded.*
- Seek and support funding to enable local people to qualify and lead a range of sports, cultural and craft pursuits – *this has been achieved by the very successful N&N Network, a collaboration between parishioners, School and Parish Council to provide courses on all of the above. Also funding of Optimist dinghies for use by the School and the wider community, in partnership with Yealm Yacht Club, brings sailing opportunities to all young people in the Parish.*

New points:

- *Consider Playing Field in Noss being designated as a Village Green.*
- *Clear and tidy the Noss play area.*
