

# NEWTON & NOSS PARISH PLAN 2004 : SECTION 6 UPDATED 2009

## COMMUNITY SERVICES & FACILITIES

### REVIEW

#### Outcome:

- The demand for educational and social facilities has been addressed by Newton & Noss Network and U3A – refer to the A5 Blue Book. Two new clubs are thriving - New Noss Adventures and the Sailing Club – both available for young people
- Medical facilities are available at Bishops Court on certain days. Chiropody and Physiotherapy services are also offered in the Parish.
- The number of halls has reduced with the closure of the Methodist Hall. There was concern that the opening of the School Hall would create further downward pressure on the existing halls.
- Environmental issues can be improved by adding a village clean-up to the existing annual harbour clean-up.
- A café has opened at The Green. Coffee/tea is available at The Dolphin. Cream teas are served at the Village Hall on certain days in summer.
- Police coverage of the area has improved slightly.

#### Issues:

- Indoor leisure facilities need to be improved.
- Recycling in the Parish seems to be working well.
- A viable Youth Club is needed and maybe the enlarged Sports Pavilion can be used for occasional meetings.

#### The way forward:

- Improve publicity and marketing of existing facilities. Provision of information boards/panels is under consideration.
- Produce a newsletter in addition to the Parish Magazine and The Nose.
