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NOSS HARD DINGHY PARKING

RULES FOR SPACE ALLOCATION March 2021/22

ELIGIBILITY

Applications will only be considered from parishioners who are full time residents and whose names appear on the current Register of Electors [or the parent's name in the case of an application from a minor].

SPACE ALLOCATION

An application form [obtainable from the Clerk] **MUST** be completed in **FULL** and submitted to the Parish Council. The Clerk will endeavour to allocate **one specific space for boats/dinghies on the Hard OR a maximum of two canoe/kayak spaces on the canoe rack per household subject to space availability.** The maximum number of kayaks permitted per section on the ground level is four. The remaining levels are limited to two per section. A small dinghy/canoe on top of another boat on Noss Hard will be permitted. Each space allocation will be valid for a maximum of 12 months.

TRAILERS

No empty or broken trailers or trolleys will be permitted at any time.

LENGTH

Dinghies and trailers must not exceed 14 feet overall.

HARBOUR AUTHORITY

Applications for dinghies/craft cannot be processed until a current registration disc has been obtained from the Harbourmaster, the number of which should be included on the application form submitted to the Clerk. A copy of each successful application will be given to the Harbourmaster.

NB. The registration disc must be displayed on each dinghy.

IDENTIFICATION

Each trailer, trolley, kayak, canoe and dinghy should display a contact number to ease identification.

WINTER STORAGE

All the above rules will apply.

OWNERS' RESPONSIBILITIES Each owner will be required to ensure that: -

- The above rules are complied with;
- **The boat park is kept tidy with consideration given to other dinghy/canoe/kayak owners.**
- All property is looked after and not left unchecked for months at a time;
- All property is left at the owners' risk.

THE PARISH COUNCIL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PROPERTY: -

- Where the owner is known to be ineligible for space, e.g. not a full-time resident of the Parish or on the Electoral Roll, **or**
- Which is not registered with the Clerk, **or**
- in respect of which no application form has been submitted or in respect of which there has been an unsuccessful application, **or**
- Which does not display a current Harbour Authority disc, **or**
- Which does not comply with the foregoing Rules.
