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BIG SLIP QUAY DINGHY/KAYAK PARKING

RULES FOR SPACE ALLOCATION 2022

ELIGIBILITY

Applications will only be considered from parishioners who are full time residents of Newton Ferrers/Noss Mayo and whose names appear on the current Register of Electors for Newton & Noss [or the parent's name in the case of an application from a minor].

SPACE ALLOCATION

An application form [obtainable from the Clerk] must be submitted to the Parish Council **each year**. A small dinghy/canoe on top of another boat will be permitted. Each space allocated will be valid for a maximum of 6 or 12 months.

USE OF BIG SLIP QUAY

The Parish Council provides space on Big Slip Quay to help enable residents to use the river regularly. The storage here is not intended for kayaks or dinghies which are not in regular use and which can be stored elsewhere.

STORAGE CHARGES 2022 [Charges are reviewed by the Parish Council in December/January annually]

Outhauls	£40 per annum
Dinghies/kayaks on the quay	£6.00 per foot per annum
Dinghies stored vertically against the wall	£3.00 per foot per annum
Kayaks/canoes stored vertically alongside the wall	£3.00 per foot per annum

TRAILERS

No empty or broken trailers or trolleys will be permitted at any time.

LENGTH

Dinghies must not exceed 13 feet overall.

HARBOUR AUTHORITY

Applications cannot be processed until a current registration disc has been obtained from the Harbourmaster, the number of which should be included on the application form submitted to the Clerk. A copy of each successful application will be given to the Harbourmaster. **NB. The registration disc must be displayed on each dinghy/canoe/kayak and be clearly visible.**

IDENTIFICATION

Each trailer, trolley, canoe, kayak and dinghy should display a contact number to ease identification.

OWNERS' RESPONSIBILITIES Each owner will be required to ensure that:

- The above rules are complied with;
- The quay is kept tidy;
- All property is looked after and checked regularly;
- All property is left at the owners' risk.

THE PARISH COUNCIL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PROPERTY:

- Where the owner is known to be ineligible for space, eg not a full-time resident of the Parish, or
- Which is not registered with the Clerk, **or**
- Which does not display a current Harbour Authority disc, or
- Which does not comply with the foregoing Rules.
