Signage Policy

This policy relates to land comprising The Green (the parcel of land immediately in front of the WI Hall,) Dillon's Green and the triangular piece of land by "Fiveways" on Parsonage Road.

Newton & Noss Parish Council own Dillon's Green and The Green triangle. The Parish Council has assumed responsibility for The Green, being a registered Village Green.

The Parish Council will consider applications for the erection of temporary signage for Parish community events. The Parish Council will not consent to applications for signage of a political, commercial or sensitive/offensive nature.

All unauthorised signage will be removed and disposed of by the Parish Council.

Only one sign will be permitted on the land at any one time. Signage should comply with South Hams District Council planning regulations.

Applications for temporary signage on all three pieces of land should be submitted to the Parish Council, in writing or by email, a minimum of fourteen days before the sign is due to be erected.

In submitting the application, the applicant is agreeing to;

1. The sign must be kept clean and tidy.
2. The sign must be kept in a safe condition and regularly inspected - particularly after strong wind conditions.
3. The sign must not obscure visibility for road users.
4. With respect to signage on the triangle, the sign must be centred in the middle of the triangle and set back from the roadsides by a minimum of 8 feet.
5. Any frame for the sign should be no higher than three feet.
6. The sign may be put up fourteen days before the event being advertised and removed within three days after the event
7. The sign will be removed within 24 hours if requested to do so.
8. The applicant assumes responsibility for any damage caused by, or consequential to their sign being erected, howsoever caused.

The Parish Council will not accept responsibility for any damage caused to the sign whilst on Parish Council land.
